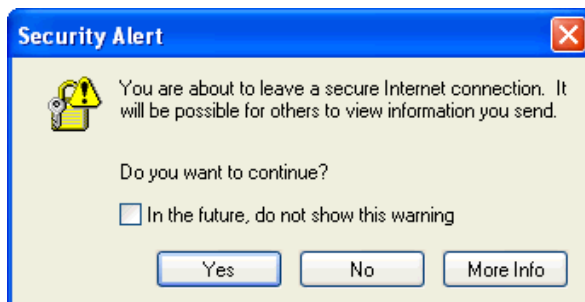
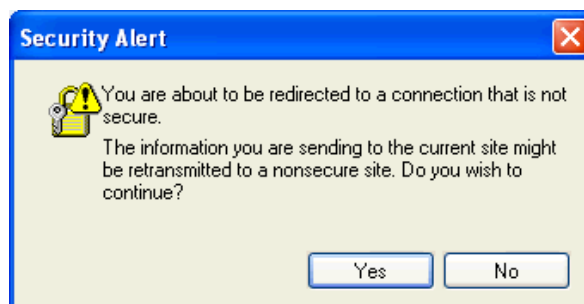
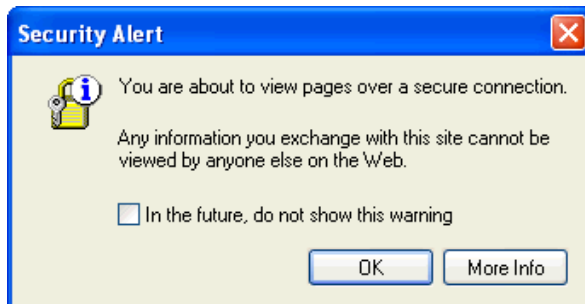
When I login or logout on www.mdl.com I get a Security Alert message box that says I am going to a secure site or a nonsecure site. What does this mean?

Answer

When you login or logout on www.mdl.com, your user name and password are encrypted for security. Although the Web page itself does not have an "https" URL, the login component of this page is a separate form that utilizes a secure protocol (https) to pass the information from the browser to our secure server. The user name and password are encrypted (128-bit) during this transmission. Once the login is complete, you will be redirected back to the Web page that you originated from.

Depending upon your browser settings, you may or may not see a Security Alert message(s) alerting you that information is being transmitted to a secure site or nonsecure site. This message is notifying you that the login process is passing through our secure server and back to your originating Web page. Your login information is protected.
